Mayor Palmer proclaimed September 17th through September 23rd as Constitution Week in the City of Oak Point.

5. Conduct a public hearing to receive input on the City of Oak Point proposed budget for FY 2020-2021.

Mayor Palmer opened the public hearing for the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Budget at 6:05 pm. Mayor Palmer announced that this budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$232,650 or 9.12%, and of that amount, \$139,685 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year. A copy of the proposed budget is available for public review in the administrative offices of the City of Oak Point, or on the City website at www.oakpointtexas. No one was in attendance; no one came forward to speak on the Public Hearing. Mayor Palmer closed the public hearing at 6:05 pm.

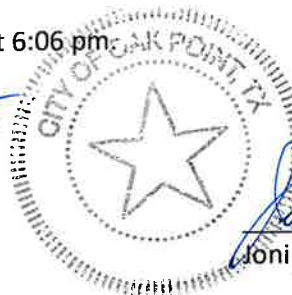
Mayor Palmer announced that the City Council will vote on the proposed tax rate and the proposed budget on Monday, September 21st at 6:00 pm.
