#### **1.0 PURPOSE**

## Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance to automatic fire alarm responses. Automatic fire alarms include any automatic fire alarms where no fire suppression system or heat detector has been activated

#### 2.0 SCOPE

This SOP/SOG pertains to all personnel in this organization.

## 3.0 POLICY/GUIDELINES & INFORMATION

# Response

- General Fire alarm- 1 Engine.
- Water Flow alarm- 2 Engines.
- High Risk Business alarms- 2 Engines.

### **Procedure**

- Full PPE and SCBA must be worn.
- Access the alarm panel to determine origin and causation of the alarm
- Confirm or disprove the presence of fire or other hazardous condition

## Fire or Smoke Encountered

- Contact dispatch for full 1st alarm assignment
- Refer to the Structure Fire SOP

# No Hazards Found

- Attempt to reset the alarm system
- If system cannot be reset attempt to contact the building representative

# **Disregard Guideline**

 Units may be disregarded only if fire or police personnel on the scene determine no hazards exist

#### General

- At the discretion of the company officer, response may be upgraded
- SCBA mask doesn't have to be worn but must be readily available
- Do not disassemble or disable any portion of the Fire Alarm System without the owners consent.
