

6. Update on Golf Cart parking at the NW corner of Jakes Place Park.

City Staff Henry showed a picture of the completed Golf Cart parking area at the northwest corner of Jakes Place Park. At a previous PARC meeting the Commission approved up to \$800.00 for materials to create the space. Per City Manager Ashley, the work came in under budget and staff would email the Commission the final cost at a later date.

7. Discuss lighting quote for the walkway and field area of Jakes Place Park.

Chairperson S. Cox suggested that the Commission take time to look at the lighting quote as well as possibly getting an additional quote. The Commission would revisit park lighting at a future PARC meeting.

8. Discuss Landscaping options for Jakes Place Park.

Chairperson S. Cox and City Staff Henry explained to the Commission that contact had been made with 3 Landscape Companies. Potentially one Company had expressed the ability to design a beautician package based on a walk thru and conversation had with Chairperson S. Cox and City Staff. After several attempts of trying to get the project started, communication stopped. It was suggested that the City contact a Landscape Architect to assist with the project. A quote from the Plant Concierge gave a price of \$100.00 per hour with a 4-hour minimum for design fees. Several suggestions were made to get additional quotes and look at who other neighboring Cities have used. Updates will be provided at a future PARC meeting.

9. Update on Corp. property.

Deputy Mayor Pro Tem S. Dufford gave an update on the cleared Privet along Yacht Club Road. An update and picture were also provided on the completed Yackport. Deputy Mayor Pro Tem S. Dufford spoke on the Boat Launch area and the benefits of a lease Vs. a license. S. Dufford recommended applying for a lease with a wish list of additions Oak Point residents would like to see. Once the lease is approved with all added amenities residents can choose what they truly want. S. Dufford will write up the lease for Corp. consideration.
