1. Call to Order, Roll Call, and Determination of Quorum.

Mayor Pro Tem Lusk called the meeting to order at 4:33 p.m. with Mayor Pro Tem Lusk and Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Dufford in attendance. Only two Council members are required to canvass the vote.

2. Consider and act upon an ordinance canvassing and certifying the results from the general election conducted on May 7, 2022 for the purpose of electing three (3) City Council members.

Mayor Pro Tem Lusk announced the results of the general election declaring John Lusk, Scott Dufford, and Kirk Hawrysiu duly elected by the registered voters of the City of Oak Point.

Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Scott Dufford made a motion to approve an ordinance canvassing and certifying the results from the general election conducted on May 7, 2022 for the purpose of electing three (3) City Council members; motion seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Lusk.

3. Consider and act upon an ordinance canvassing and certifying the results from the Special Election conducted on May 7, 2022 for the purpose of considering a proposition to reauthorize a ¼% sales tax for street maintenance.

Mayor Pro Tem Lusk announced the results of the special election declaring Proposition A passed reauthorizing the one-fourth of one percent sales tax for street maintenance by the registered voters of the City of Oak Point.

Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Scott Dufford made a motion to approve an ordinance canvassing and certifying the results from the the Special Election conducted on May 7, 2022 for the purpose of considering a proposition to reauthorize a ¼% sales tax for street maintenance; motion seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Lusk.
